Hurricane Harvey Impacts McAllen International Airport Flights

Approximately half a dozen flights already cancelled due to expected weather conditions at airports, fuel refineries across Texas

(MCALLEN, TX) While the rest of Texas braces for Hurricane Harvey's landfall, McAllen's International Airport (MFE) is feeling some of the effects of that storm. United Airlines is cancelling all mid-day and evening operations for today, which means approximately six UA flights in and out of MFE will be cancelled because of expected weather conditions at Houston International Airport. Airport officials are pending notification if any flights are expected to be cancelled for tomorrow Saturday, August 26.

As more information becomes available, MFE will continue to notify the media and the public.

McAllen International Airport advises customers to stay in touch with their air carriers for the most accurate information regarding specific flight status, as well as re-booking options.
